This policy applies to members of the Isles of Scilly Golf Club.

SCOPE OF PRIVACY POLICY

We are committed to maintaining the privacy and confidentiality of information provided by you to us. Our aim is to be as clear and open as possible about what we do with your personal data and why we do it. The term 'personal data' refers to personally identifiable information about you as defined in the Data Protection Act 2018.

COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA INCLUDING EMAIL ADDRESSES

When you apply to join the Isles of Scilly Golf Club, we request personal information about you such as your name, postal address, email address, telephone number and date of birth. The information you provide is manually and electronically stored.

USE OF PERSONAL DATA

We will only ask for data that is adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary. When we send you correspondence it will be sent by email. We will use the personal data you provide to:

- Send you regular updates about the club, including competition dates and results.
- Issue invoices, manage accounts and records, and collect payments and debts.
- Register you with England Golf for use of the World Handicap System.
- Comply with legal requirements.

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We will not sell your personal data.

DATA ACCESS AND CORRECTIONS

Upon receipt of a written request, we will disclose to you the personal data we hold about you. We will also correct, amend or delete any personal data that is inaccurate. Requests to delete personal data are subject to any reporting or document retention obligations imposed on us.

YOUR RIGHTS

Your personal data is protected by legal rights. For more information or to exercise your data protection rights, please contact us using the contact details below. You also have a right to complain to the Information Commissioner's Office, which regulates the processing of personal data.
